The venerated bard of Beverina awakens the spirit of the people with the power
of his song, bringing the nation victory over besieging armies.

Valdemārs Ozoliņš (1897-1973) BELOVED LATVIA (J. Sanders)

Beautiful Latvia, our cherished homeland, we pledge to you our strength and our lives.

Jānis Norvīlis (1906-) FROM THIS LAND (Author unknown)

A child's dreams of shaping his homeland are shattered by its loss but the longing of the exiles will one day realize the dream.

Emīls Dārziņš (1875-1910) UPROOTED PINES (J. Rainis)

A hostile force has destroyed the proud pines but they maintain their strength and emerge from despair in a different form to await a new dawn.

Jēkabs Graubiņš (1886-1961) ORPHAN'S LAMENT (Folk song)

The orphan yearns for his mother but cannot summon her. although the sun can warm the child, it has no word of comfort to offer.

soloist: **Ileāna Pētersone**

Ruta Brože (1953-) THREE TREES IN THE PINEWOOD (Folk song)

Of three pines of equal stature only one remains when the second is cut and the third breaks in a storm. Of three beautiful daughters only one remains at home when the other two are married.

Women's choir:

Jānis Kalniņš (1904-) SING WE ALL TOGETHER (Folk song)

If the singing of the bride's well-wishers is harmonious and their advice is good, then her married life will be happy.

Jānis Norvīlis (1906-) AWAITING EVENTIDE (Folk song)

A serf despairs of day's end bringing with it rest from the hard labour set by his merciless master.

Conductor: **Arvīds Purvs**

Mixed choir:

Arvīds Purvs (1926-) THE CAREFREE LIFE (Folk Song)

In this allegorical song a young soldier reminisces the good life he had on his father's lands.

Conductor: **Arvīds Purvs**

Imants Mežaraups (1958-) A CHILD'S DEVOTION (Folk song)

A devoted child recalls the love and tenderness his mother bestowed on him at the cradle and awaiting his home-coming.

Conductor: **Vizma Maksiņa**

Male choir:

Helmers Pavasars (1903-) I BRIDLED A FERRET (Folk song)

In this humorous song, a young man on his way to seek a wife, boasts that horsemen are willing to trade their steeds for his ferret.

Emīls Dārziņš (1875-1910) AS THE STARLIGHT (K. Jēkabsons)

A young man asks his beloved to reflect the light of the stars and the moon, to shine like the rising sun, to be as bright as the new-fallen snow and then to accompany him on a pilgrimage to find the beauty of his homeland.

Conductor: **Ernests Brusubārdis III**

Mixed choir:

Imants Sakss (1918-) SUNSET ON STABURAGS (I. Kalnāre)

In this lyrical song, the glorious sunset on the cliff inspires a boatman to seek an anchorage for his boat. A maiden from Courland aids him and he asks her to be his bride.

Jānis Cīrulis (1897-1962) ILLUSIONS (K. Skalbe)

In search of enlightenment the poet wanders through blue-green forests finding only disillusionment.

Jāzeps Vītols (1863-1948) CASTLE OF LIGHT (Auseklis)

This song tells of a mythical castle of light which prospered in freedom. Then came war and slavery. The castle disappeared until a new generation would discover the secret of light and liberty.

Andrejs Jurjāns 1856-1922 THE FALCON AND THE LINDEN TREE (Folk song)

A falcon discovers that the branches of his favourite linden tree have been broken off by young lovers and flung into the River Daugava.

Emīls Melngailis (1874-1954) NIGHT IN THE MEADOW (Folk song)

A young man puts his steed into the pasture for the night asking God to keep his horse safe. He loses his horse in a heavy mist but recovers him in the morning.

Dace Štāvere-Aperāne (1953-) THE FLOWERING GRAINFIELD (Folk song)

With the coming of summer, a maiden's brothers have time to build a granary, but she asks them to build her a room with three doors, one for the rising sun, one for the setting sun and one to lead her to her life's path.

Emīls Melngailis (1874-1954) DAWN (Folk song)

A young swain rides out at sunrise to seek his bride. He passes through three gardens, to find his beloved in the third one.

Conductor: **Ernests Brusubārdis III**

Bruno Skulte (1905-1976) Cantata SHIELD OF SONG (J. Veselis and A. Eglītis)

The unifying spirit of song, exalting the beauty of Latvia serves as a mighty shield against evil and gives courage to the nation.

Andrejs Jurjāns (1856-1922) FOR MY HOMELAND (A. Jurjāns)

We raise up our voices in supplication to God to protect the land of our forefathers from iniquity and to grant freedom and prosperity
