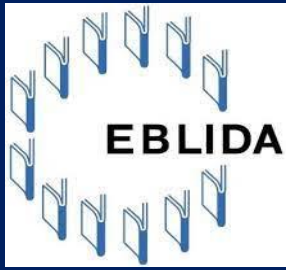

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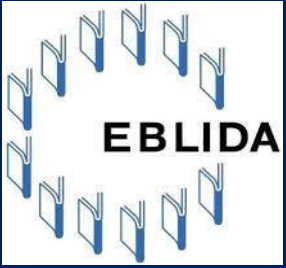

# RL:EU Objectives

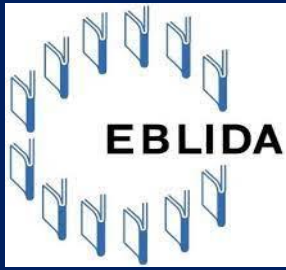
- Improve the participation of public community libraries as adult learning centres into EU funding programmes (international partnerships should double within 2 years);

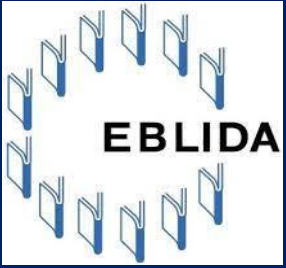

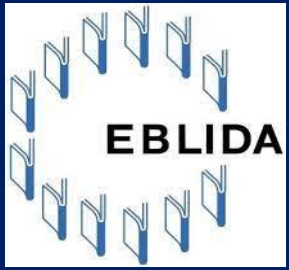

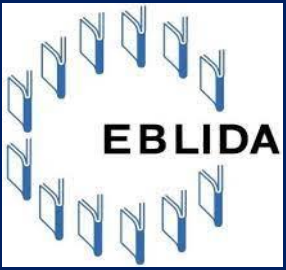

# ERASMUS + (2021-2027)

Budget: €26.2 billion, nearly double the funding compared to its predecessor programme (2014-2020).

Strong focus on social inclusion, the green and digital transitions, and promoting young people's participation in democratic life.



# ERASMUS + (2021-2027)

The programme supports the European Pillar of Social Rights (20 principles) including **Education, training and life-long learning**, Men and women be treated in the same fair way, equal opportunities, equal treatment, fair pay, **basic services**: access to things like water, electricity, banking and internet.
