- Regulation of Library,
- Development Strategy,
- Terms of Use of the Library,
- Acquisition Policy, etc.

The library collection is organizing and managing according to the status and type of the library.

Legal status of the library:

- State Library
- Municipal library
- Private library

The legal status determines that a library is founded, financed, reorganised and liquidated by the State government, local government or private institution.

The organizing of library collection is independent and not restricted by political, ideological or religious motives. Restrictions can only be established by law.

Books and other documents that encourages to national, ethnic, religious hatred, racism, terrorism, as well books and other documents against the State of Latvia and its symbols are not included in the library collection.

The exception is libraries which receives the Legal deposit and libraries in which these publications are assembled for research purposes.

It is prohibited to include illegally obtained books and other documents (for example, stolen) in the library collection.

- Donation from Riga City Council member 5000 rubles
- The library collection contained 2976 books
- Every day more than 230 visitors in first month



Collection of the Riga Central Library

At the end of 2022 collection contained 668 981 books and other materials

Material types

- 87 % books
- 7 % periodical
- 4 % audiovisuals
- 1 % electronical
- 1 % notes, maps, pictures, etc.

Languages

- 72 % in Latvian
- 21 % in Russian
- 5 % in English
- 1 % in German
- 1 % other languages (Italian, Lithuanian, Estonian, Polish, Ukrainian, etc.)

Organizing and development the collection of Riga Central Library is determined by Acquisition policy, which is updated every 4 years.

Policy reflects:

- Library structure,
- Sources of funding,
- Sources of acquisition,
- Selection criteria of acquisition,
- Use of unified collection,
- Procedure for accepting and using gifts,
- Work and members of Acquisition Board,
- Collection development.

Acquisition Board of Riga Central Library

Members: Director of RCL, Deputy Director of RCL, experts of Library Service, Head and experts of Acquisition and Processing Department, Head of RCL Branch Libraries.

- □ Meeting is held once a month.
- Decides on the purchase of the latest books and other materials; decides on the acceptance of gifts.

Riga Central Library has unified collection and every user has one Reader card, that can be used in all Branch libraries.

- Riga Central Library (main building) has the biggest collection of Fiction, Art literature, Music literature, children literature.
- □ Some Branch Libraries has special collections:
 - Department of Pedagogical Literature,
 - In Branch Library "Vidzeme"- literature about Latvia,
 - In Daugava Branch Library literature about Latvia's historical region Latgale,
 - In Branch Library "Pārdaugava" Medical literature,
 - In Branch Library "Torņakalns" literature about sport and healthy lifestyle,
 - In Branch Library "Avots" special collection of Latvian publisher Helmars Rudzītis.

□ Inter Library Loan (ILL) between Branch Libraries and between libraries in Latvia.

- Security system in Branch Library "Pārdaugava"





Repository of Riga Central Library

□ Active Collection - literature, not older than 10 years, 1 copy in Latvian and foreign languages for use in RCB and Branch Libraries

Passive Collection - rarely used but valuable literature published before 2000.

Exchange Collection - redundant duplicates, gifts in good condition:

- supports RCL and Branch libraries,
- provides collections of External Service Points, Beach Library, Book Exchange Points,
- Complements the collections of School Libraries in Riga, as well as EU4Dialogueother libraries in Latvia.
